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# 2020 Christmas Parade: **Toys, Trains & Candy Canes**

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## **- RULES & INFORMATION -**

### **RULES**

1. Parade officials will inspect each float and reserve the right to eliminate any entry that is in violation of the rules.
2. Once your entry has started along the parade route, no one may enter or exit your float.
3. Floats may not exit the parade route before the end of the parade.
4. Entries with children under the age of nineteen (19) **must** have one (1) adult per five (5) children. A list of the supervising adult names and phone numbers **must** be on the entry form.
5. Due to insurance regulations, **nothing may be thrown** from your parade float. Additionally, you are not allowed to hand out anything to parade watchers. **No exceptions whatsoever. Any persons who violate this will be asked to leave parade lineup and be expelled from future participation. Again, this is not a Chamber decision, but a restriction in place by the Chambers Event Insurance.**
6. Absolutely **NO** alcohol is permitted.
7. No performances that require the float/participant to stop will be allowed along parade route.

### **PARADE ROUTE/TIME**

The parade will begin promptly at 6 p.m. on Saturday, December 12, 2020. Floats and/or entries may check in at their DESIGNATED AREA beginning at 4:30 p.m. **All floats and/or entries must be lined up and ready no later than 5:30 p.m.** to help ensure the parade goes smoothly. The parade will head east on Walker Street from North Miller Street. The parade will continue east, exiting right for a conclusion at Miller Park. Floats may tear down at Miller Park, however, no float trash or items will be allowed to be left at park. This will be monitored. All float materials must be disposed of properly. DO NOT dispose of float items in City/Park Dumpsters.

### **JUDGING**

All entries will be introduced when they are in front of the courthouse. Each float or entry who elects to be judged will be judged on the interpretation of the theme ("Toys, Trains & Candy Canes"), creativity, and originality. The judge's trailer will be on the north side of Walker Street in front of the courthouse.

### **APPLICATION DEADLINE**

All completed parade entry forms must be received at the Breckenridge Chamber of Commerce, 100 East Elm Street, by 5:00 p.m. on Friday December 4, 2020. **ABSOLUTELY NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED.** A map of the parade route, staging areas, and list of entries will be posted to the Breckenridge Chamber of Commerce's website ([www.breckenridgetexas.com](http://www.breckenridgetexas.com)) and Facebook page ([www.facebook.com/BreckenridgeChamberOfCommerce](https://www.facebook.com/BreckenridgeChamberOfCommerce)) by noon on Wednesday, December 09, 2020, if not earlier.

I, the participant/float representative and undersigned, hereby acknowledge that I have knowingly and willingly entered an Activity Agreement, or become a party bound by the terms and conditions of the Activity Agreement by and with the Breckenridge Chamber of Commerce (sponsor). I understand the terms, provisions, and conditions of the Activity Agreement, its warnings and agree to abide by its terms, provisions, and conditions.
