RESIGNATION OF INTERIM CITY MANAGER

[Breckenridge] - On June 13, 2022, the City Commission of the City of Breckenridge approved an Agreement for Interim City Manager with Texas First Group LLC. This Agreement provided that Jim Cox, of Texas First Group, would serve as Interim City Manager for the City of Breckenridge. Mr. Cox's first day of work was June 21, 2022. On Monday, June 27, 2022, Mr. Cox verbally resigned from the position of Interim City Manager, effective June 24, 2022.

The City Commission is in the process of selecting a new Interim City Manager and/or permanent City Manager. The City Commission takes seriously the task of selecting a suitable City Manager so that the citizens of the City will be adequately served and the business of the City will be efficiently performed.

Interim City Manager services are necessitated by the resignation of former City Manager, Erika McComis, effective June 22, 2022.
