BOND CONDITIONS

Offense(s): Sexual Assault of a Child (F2)

Pursuant to Code of Criminal Procedure Art. 17.40, the court finds that certain bond conditions related to the safety of the victim of the alleged offense and/or the safety of the community will secure the defendant's attendance at trial and/or are required by law. In addition to other conditions required by the bond itself, the court imposes the bond conditions indicated below by an "x" or "√" as follows:

- 1. **No new crimes.** Do not commit any offense against the laws of this state, any other state, or the United States.
- 2. **No drug use.** Do not use, possess or consume marijuana or any controlled substance, narcotic, or dangerous drug unless prescribed lawfully by a physician; in the manner prescribed.
- 3. **Curfew.** Be at your residence by **9:00 p.m.** and remain there until **6:00 a.m.** except when at work or school or on a direct route going to or from work or school.
- 4. **No Weapons.** Do not possess any firearm, bow, crossbow, club, or knife (other than those typically used for the purpose of preparing food).
- _____ 5. **Leave victim(s) alone.** Do not initiate any oral, written, telephone, text, or electronic communications with

_____ or any household member of said individual(s), and do not go within 100 yards of victim or said individuals or the following:

- _____ 6. **Interlock.** Do not operate any motor vehicle unless the vehicle is equipped with an ignition interlock device.¹ Within 30 days of your release from jail, you must install this device at your expense and report to the Young/Stephens Counties Bond Supervision Department located at the Young County Sheriff's Department in Graham, TX (940-521-6356) and the Breckenridge Police Department in Breckenridge, TX (940-521-6356) to verify the installation. If you do not operate a motor vehicle, you must still report to the Bond Supervision Office to verify that you do not operate a motor vehicle. (This bond condition is **mandatory** pursuant to CCP Art. 17.441 for persons accused of **DWI 2nd, DWI 3rd, Intoxication Assault, and Intoxication Manslaughter** unless the magistrate finds that requiring the device would not be in the best interests of justice.)

- _____ 7. **School or work.** Attend school regularly or obtain and maintain suitable employment; support your dependents.

- 8. **Avoid bad people and places.** Avoid persons or places of disreputable or harmful character, including any place alcoholic beverages are sold for "on premises" consumption except for restaurants where food is prepared on site.

- _____ 9. **Attend AA.** Attend Alcoholics Anonymous meetings _____ times per week.

- _____ 10. **Attend NA.** Attend Narcotics Anonymous meetings _____ times per week.

- 11. **No travel.** Do not leave Young/Stephens or Stephens County, Texas for an overnight stay unless necessary for court attendance without prior approval of bond supervisor.

- 12. **Drug tests.** Submit to and pay \$20 for random specimen analysis tests at the Young/Stephens Counties Bond Supervision Department, Graham, TX (940-521-6356) and Breckenridge, TX (940-521-6356); submit proof of any medication prescribed for you before submitting a specimen. Lab fees may apply.

¹ A device that uses a deep-lung breath analysis mechanism to make impractical the operation of a motor vehicle if ethyl alcohol is detected in the breath of the operator.

- 13. **DNA sample.** Pursuant to CCP Art. 17.47, submit a DNA sample to the Young/Stephens County Sheriff's Department prior to your release from custody. (**Mandatory** for Aggravated Kidnapping (by inflicting bodily injury or violating or abusing sexually), Indecency with a Child, Sexual Assault, Aggravated Sexual Assault, Prohibited Sexual Conduct, Burglary of a Habitation (with intent to commit a felony other than theft), Compelling Prostitution, Sexual Performance by a Child, or Possession of Promotion of Child Pornography)
- 14. **Under 14 victim.** Pursuant to CCP Art. 17.41, since the alleged victim, _____, is under 14, do not directly communicate with him or her and do not go within 100 yards of the victim or following:

 [**Mandatory** for all Chapter 21 crimes (sexual offenses), all Chapter 22 crimes (assaultive offenses), Prohibited Sexual Conduct, and Sexual Performance by a Child.]
- 15. **Not to be around children under the age of 18.** Avoid any circumstances where you could potentially become alone with a child under the age of 18. Any child under the age of 18 in your presence must be accompanied by a parent, guardian or supervising adult. Stay away from any location where children gather, ex: playgrounds, parks, schools, sporting events, etc.
- 16. **No alcohol.** Do not purchase or consume alcoholic beverages.
- 17. **Reporting.** You shall report to the Bond Supervision Office **1x Monthly** _____ **Bi-Weekly** _____ **Weekly** _____ per month until further order of the Court.
- 18. **Ankle Monitor.** Defendant must participate in the Electronic Monitoring program through the 90th Judicial District Bond Supervision Department and shall pay all costs associated with said monitoring. Defendant shall enroll in the Electric Monitoring program by (check one the following)
 - prior to release from incarceration;**
 - next business day;
- 19. **Field Visits.** Allow a representative of the 90th Judicial District Bond Supervision Department to conduct field visits at Defendant's residence and place of employment to confirm compliance with these conditions.
- 20. **A fee of \$60 per month will be charged when reporting to bond supervision.**
- 21. **Delinquent Bond Supervision Fees.** Any delinquent bond supervision fees that have not been paid at the time of adjudication will be referred to the court for consideration of payment.
- 22. **Address and Phone Number(s).** You must keep the Bond Supervision officer updated on all address or phone number changes.
- 23. **Other:** _____

This order is effective immediately and shall continue in effect until modified by order of this court or another court.

If you violate this order your bond may be forfeited, revoked, or increased, and you may be subject to confinement until the conclusion of the criminal case against you. Additionally, you may be punished for contempt of court by a fine of \$100.00 or by confinement in jail for as long as three days or both.
