Boil Water Notice for Community Public Water Systems 05.14.2026

Due to a water line repair, the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has required the public water system to notify all customers to boil their water prior to consumption (e.g., washing hands/face, brushing teeth, drinking, etc.). Children, seniors, and persons with weakened immune systems are particularly vulnerable to harmful bacteria, and all customers should follow these directions).

To ensure destruction of all harmful bacteria and other microbes, water for drinking, cooking, and ice making should be boiled and cooled prior to use for drinking water or human consumption purposes. The water should be brought to a vigorous rolling boil and then boiled for two minutes.

In lieu of boiling, individuals may purchase bottled water or obtain water from some other suitable source for drinking water or human consumption purposes.

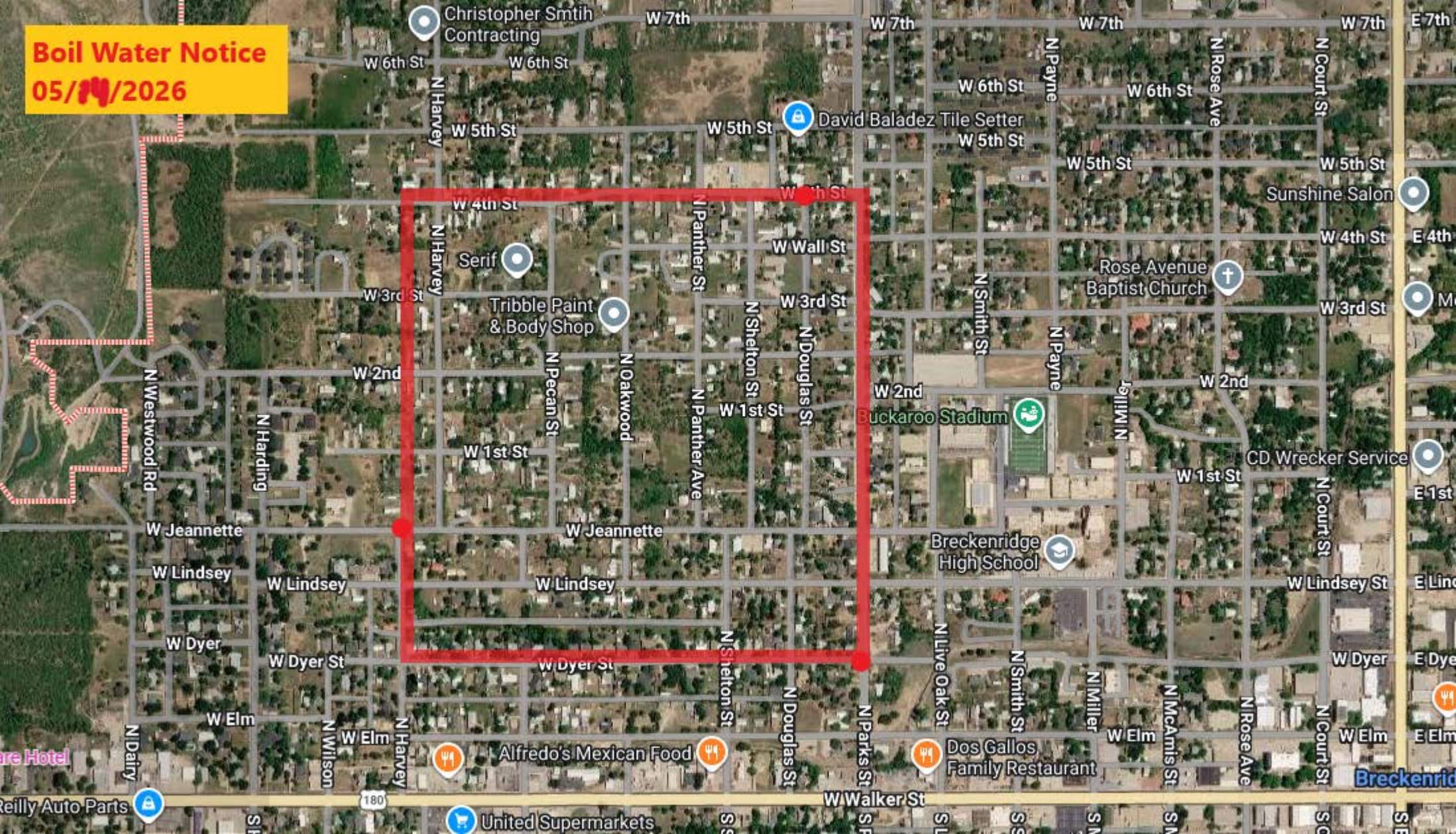
When it is no longer necessary to boil the water, the public water system officials will notify customers that the water is safe for drinking water or human consumption purposes.

Once the boil water notice is no longer in effect, the public water system will issue a notice to customers that rescinds the boil water notice in a manner like this notice.

The affected area is to include the intersection of N. Harvey. and W. 4th, moving south to W. Dyer St., traveling east to N. Parks St., then continuing north to W. 4th, and finally going west to N. Harvey. This will also include the cross street of N. Pecan, N Oakwood, N Panther, N Shelton, N Douglas, W Wall, W 3rd, W 2nd, W 1st, W Jeannette, and W Lindsey. (Please see the map)

Aviso de ebullición de agua para sistemas públicos comunitarios de agua 05.14.2026

Debido a una reparación en una línea de agua, la Comisión de Calidad Ambiental de Texas ha exigido al sistema público de agua que notifique a todos los clientes que hiervan el agua antes de consumirla (por ejemplo, lavarse las manos/cara, cepillarse los dientes, beber, etc.). Los niños, personas mayores y personas con sistemas inmunitarios debilitados son especialmente vulnerables a bacterias dañinas, y todos los clientes deben seguir estas instrucciones.

Para asegurar la destrucción de todas las bacterias dañinas y otros microbios, el agua para beber, cocinar y fabricar hielo debe hervirse y enfriarse antes de usarla para consumo de agua potable o de consumo humano. El agua debe hervirse vigorosamente y luego hervirse durante dos minutos.

En lugar de hervir, las personas pueden comprar agua embotellada o obtener agua de alguna otra fuente adecuada para consumo potable o humano.

Cuando ya no sea necesario hervir el agua, los responsables del sistema público notificarán a los clientes que el agua es segura para el consumo o para el consumo humano.

Una vez que el aviso de hervir agua deje de estar en vigor, el sistema público emitirá un aviso a los clientes que revocará el aviso de hervir agua de una manera similar a este.

La zona afectada incluirá la intersección de N. Harvey y W. 4th, avanzando hacia el sur hasta W. Dyer St., viajando hacia el este hasta N. Parks St., luego continuando hacia el norte hasta W. 4th y finalmente hacia el oeste hasta N. Harvey. Esto también incluirá la calle transversal de N. Pecan, N Oakwood, N Panther, N Shelton, N Douglas, W Wall, W 3rd, W 2nd, W 1st, W Jeannette y W Lindsey. (Por favor, consulta el mapa)
