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RULES & INFORMATION

RULES:

1. Parade officials will inspect and reserve the right to eliminate any entry that is violation of the rules.
2. Once your entry has started along the parade route, no one may enter or exit your float.
3. Floats may not exit the parade route before the end of the parade.
4. No alcohol is permitted.
5. For the safety of everyone, nothing may be thrown from your parade float; however, participants who are walking along the float may HAND items to the parade watchers.
6. Entries with children under the age of 12 must have 1 (one) adult per every 5 (five) children. A list of supervising adults' names and phone numbers must be included in the entry form.

PARADE ROUTE/TIME:

The parade will begin promptly at **7:00 pm, Wednesday, September 2nd, 2026**. Floats will start lining up at **6:00 pm**. All floats will need to check into their designated area to ensure everything runs as smoothly as possible. The parade will then proceed South on Miller Street, then turn left (East) onto Walker Street; eventually turning left (North) onto North Court Street (The East side of the Courthouse). Floats may tear down at the BHS parking lot or the TSTC parking lot.

JUDGING:

All entries will be introduced in front of the courthouse. Each float will be judged upon their theme interpretation, creativity, and originality. The judges will be located directly in front of the the courthouse lawn. (The Judges Trailer will be on the Northeast side of Walker Street)

APPLICATION DEADLINE:

All entries must be received by **Friday, August 28th, 2026**. On **Monday August 31st, 2026**, a printable map and lineup list will be posted on the BISD all sports booster club Facebook page.
